CHAPTER XLVI.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act granting a bounty to certain volunteers and militia of this state.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That those persons who volunteered from the counties of Bradford and Tioga, in this state, and put themselves under the command of general Porter, and served as non-commissioned officers, musicians or privates in Canada, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, shall be entitled to the bounty of ten dollars each, payable in the manner directed by and under the restrictions of the act entitled "An act granting a bounty to certain volunteers and militia of this state," passed the nineteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen.
