

CHAPTER LXXIII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to provide for the erection of two arsenals."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the arsenal to be built at Meadville, shall be covered with good and substantial sheet iron, well painted with oil and white lead, instead of slate or tile; and that the accountant officers be, and they are hereby authorised to allow the contractor for building the said arsenal such sum as may be necessary to meet any additional expense which may be hereby created.

Arsenal to be covered with sheet iron.

CHAPTER LXXIV.

AN ACT

To provide for the more equal distribution of the laws of this Commonwealth.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That as soon as the pamphlet laws of this Commonwealth shall have been delivered into the office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, he shall cause the same to be distributed in the manner following, that is to say, Ten copies to the clerk of the Senate for the use of the Senate; thirty copies to the clerk of the House of Representatives for the use of the House of Representatives; to the Governor one copy; to each member of the Legislature one copy; to the prothonotary of each district of the supreme court one copy; to the attorney general one copy; to each of the judges of the supreme court one copy; to the secretary of the land office, surveyor and auditor general, and state treasurer, one copy each;

Secretary to distribute the laws.
