CHAPTER CXXVII.

AN ACT

Authorising the recovery of money in the hands of certain commissioners.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the purchaser or purchasers, their heirs, executors or administrators, of any lands sold at commissioner's sales for taxes, previous to the year one thousand eight hundred, within this Commonwealth, be authorised to demand and receive any sum or sums of money which may have been by them paid to any commissioner or commissioners of any county, beyond the amount of the taxes and costs for which such lands were sold, and which hath not been paid by them to the real owner of such lands, or into the county treasury; and if upon demand of any such purchaser or purchasers, their heirs, executors or administrators, any such commissioner or commissioners shall refuse or neglect to pay such sum, the same may be recovered as other sums of the same amount are by law recoverable: Provided, That before any suit shall be commenced for the same, a bond of indemnity, with sufficient sureties to any such commissioner or commissioners, duly executed, shall be tendered, and a release of all interest in or title to any such lands under said sales, be duly executed by such purchaser or purchasers, or by their executors or administrators, who are hereby authorised and empowered to*

execute the same, and be recorded in the recorder's office of the county in which such sales were made.

CHAPTER CXXVIII.

AN ACT

Authorising William Gilliland, William Kerr and Moses McIlvain to sell and convey certain land therein mentioned.

WHEREAS a warrant was granted to John Kerr and John Monteeth, for a certain piece of land, in trust for the congregation of the Pines, in the township of Straban, in the county of Adams. And whereas the said John Kerr and John Monteeth, being both deceased, and the said congregation having become extinct, the descendents of those who were members of said congregation, have prayed the Legislature to appoint trustees to sell and convey a part of the said land, and enclose the remainder for a burial ground :

Therefore,

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall be lawful for William Gilliland, William Names of Kerr and Moses McIlvain, and the survivors or survivor of trustees, them, as trustees, to sell and convey, in fee simple, by deed of conveyance, so much of a certain piece of land in Straban township, Adams county, containing about twelve acres, more or less, adjoining lands of Abraham Fickes, William Cashman and others, which was granted by warrant to John Kerr and John Monteeth, in trust for the congregation of the Pines, as they the said trustees may judge expedient, reserving what shall be deemed by them sufficient for a burial ground for the use of the descendents of the members of the aforesaid congregation ; and after such sale and conveyance, the proceeds thereof shall be applied by the said trustees towards erecting* who shall sell a certain piece of land.
