

CHAPTER CLXVI.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to authorise the Governor to appoint commissioners for the purpose of laying out a road beginning at or near Kelso's ferry, in Cumberland county, through York and Adams counties, to the Maryland line, in a direction to the city of Washington."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to appoint three commissioners to lay out, mark and extend the state road mentioned in the said act to which this is a further supplement, beginning at or near the house of Jacob Bigler, in East Pennsborough township, in the county of Cumberland, in a north-east direction until said road shall intersect the Harrisburg and Pittsburg turnpike road at such point as the commissioners shall think proper: And the commissioners appointed shall proceed to perform the said service at such time or times as the Governor shall direct, and shall make out and deposit a draft of the said road in the office of the clerk of the court of quarter sessions in the county of Cumberland, together with the width of said road, and it shall be the duty of said clerk to enter the same of record, and it shall from thenceforth be a public highway, and shall be opened and kept in repair as roads laid out by the courts of quarter sessions in the county aforesaid; and the said commissioners and those employed by them for the purpose aforesaid, shall have and receive for their service the same compensation as is allowed by the second section of the act to which this is a further supplement, and to be paid in the same manner by the commissioners of the county of Cumberland.

Road to commence at or near J. Bigler's and intersect the Harrisburg & Pittsburg turnpike.

Draft to be deposited with the clerk of the sessions.
