

CHAPTER CLXVII.

AN ACT

For the relief of John Fisher, of the borough of Lancaster.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay unto John Fisher, of the borough of Lancaster, in the county of Lancaster, or his order, the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars, in full of his demand for services rendered as a teamster at Baltimore in the fall of eighteen hundred and fourteen.

CHAPTER CLXVIII.

AN ACT

Establishing certain election districts,

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the electors of the township of Fawn, in the county of York, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by John Nickel, in said township. York county.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the electors of the township of Springfield, in the county of Bradford, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Gurdon Grover, in said township. Bradford.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the electors of the township of White Deer, in the county of Union, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Samuel Miller, in said township. Union.
