## CHAPTER CLXXXI.

## AN ACT

Making appropriation to defray certain expenses of government therein mentioned.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That for the payment of expenses hereinafter mention-Clerk hire in ed, the following sums are hereby appropriated, to wit: For clerk hire in the office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth. for one year, two thousand three hundred dollars: For clerk Secretary of hire in the office of the Secretary of the Land Office for or year, commencing the first of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, the sum of three thousand seven hundred dollars, which together with the permanent appropriation of sixteen hundred dollars, may be expended by said officer in the employment of as many clerks in his office as he may find necessary: For clerk hire in the office of the Auditor General, one hundred dollars in addition to the permanent appropriation of one thousand dollars, and the further sum of eight hundred dollars to pay for the employment of one additional clerk in said office from the first day of April next, and also a sum of twenty five dollars for copying certain public papers in said office: For clerk hire in the office of the State Treasurer, two hundred dollars in addition to the permanent appropriation of two thousand and sixty-six dollars and sixtysix cents: For clerk hire in the office of the Surveyor General for one year, commencing on the first day of April aforesaid, the sum of two thousand six hundred dollars, which together with the permanent appropriation of two thousand dollars for that office, may be expended by the Surveyor General in the employment of as many clerks in his office as he may find necessary: For the employment of an additional clerk in the office of the State Treasurer, the sum of six hundred dollars: And the clerk hire aforesaid shall be paid quarterly in the usual manner: For contingent expences in the office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth for one year, two thousand five hundred dollars: For contingent expenses in the office of the Secretary of the Land Office for one year, two thousand dollars: For contingent expenses in the office of the Surveyor General for one year, including the expenses of the Board of Property, six hundred and seventy-five dollars: For contingent expenses in the Auditor General's Office, two hundred dollars in addition to the standing appropriation of four hundred dollars: And the sums hereby appropriated shall be paid by the state treasurer out of any money in the treasury; previous to which the officers holding the aforesaid offices, shall
