

CHAPTER XI.

AN ACT

Authorising John Shreve, Samuel Coope and Jesse Townsend, administrators of the estate of Jonah Cadwalader, to grant and convey certain real estate.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That John Shreve, Samuel Coope and Jesse Townsend, administrators of the estate of Jonah Cadwalader, late of the borough of Bridgport, Fayette county, deceased, who died intestate, be, and they are hereby authorised to make and execute a deed of conveyance to John Malcomson, of said borough, his heirs or assigns, or to such other person or persons as he the said John Malcomson shall direct, for a certain lot of ground situate in the borough aforesaid, numbered in the general plan of said borough one hundred and thirty-five, adjoining Prospect street lot numbered one hundred and thirty-four, and a lot in Tync alley belonging to Robert Townsend, and such a deed of conveyance so made by the said administrators, or the survivors of them, shall convey the like interest, and have the same force and effect, as though the same had been made by the said Jonah Cadwalader in his life time.
