

CHAPTER XXIV.

AN ACT

Authorising the Orphans' court of Northampton county to order the executors of Dewalt Albrecht to sell lands.

Orphans' court authorised to empower the executors of Dewalt Albrecht to sell real estate.

To decree contribution.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the orphans' court of Northampton county is hereby authorised and empowered to order a sale by Susanna Albrecht, John Albrecht and Jacob Steffen, executors of Dewalt Albrecht, formerly of Northampton county, deceased, of so much of a tract of land situate in Williams township, Northampton county, which the said Dewalt Albrecht purchased from a certain Stephen Krumrein, now also deceased, as will be sufficient to pay and satisfy the balance appearing to be due, or which shall appear to be due on a final settlement of their administration account, including the charge of the said executors for a compromise and determination of a dispute respecting said land, and to decree contribution amongst the devisees and legatees of the said Dewalt Albrecht, deceased, as is provided by an act of General Assembly passed the first of April eighteen hundred and eleven, and such sale shall be had, made and conducted, as in other cases of sales made under the decree of the orphans' court by the existing laws.*
