Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the title of Thomas Logan, his heirs and assigns, to a certain tract of land situate in Air township, in the Big Cove, Bedford county, containing one hundred fifty-three acres and sixty-one perches and allowance, shall be as good and available in law and equity to all intents and purposes, as if the same had been purchased from a citizen of the state of Pennsylvania, and not from Samuel Irwin, an alien: Provided, That the rights of no individual shall be impaired by this act, but the same shall be and remain as before the passing thereof.

CHAPTER XL.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act for establishing and building a bridge acrose the Raystown branch of Juniata."

Penalty on persons riding, &c. out of a walk in crossing the chain bridge over the Juniata.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the first day of May next, if any person or persons shall wilfully ride, drive or lead any horse or other creature out of a walk, when crossing the chain bridge over the Raystown branch of the Juniata, where the Philadelphia and Pittsburg road crosses the same in Bedford county, he, she or they shall on conviction thereof by one or more disinterested witnesses, forfeit and pay the sum of five dollars for every such offence, for the use of the person or persons owning the said bridge, to be recovered in like manner as debts of equal amount are by law recoverable.

SECT. 2 And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That it shall be the duty of the owner or owners of the said bridge, to place and keep up in the most conspicuous place and bridge a copy of the rates of toll keep up the to be paid, by the act to which this is a supplement; also a copy of the penalty described in the preceding section of this rate of tollin act for the information of travellers: Provided, That noth-a conspicuing herein contained shall be construed to operate against any person unless the provisions of this section shall have been Proviso. complied with on part of the owner or owners of said bridge.

CHAPTER XLI.

AN ACT

To authorise the executors of David Smith, late of Westmoreland county, deceased, to convey a certain part of a tract of land in Fayette county.

WHEREAS it is represented to the legislature that Joseph Darlington, bound himself by articles of agreement dated the first of October one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, to convey a part of a tract of land in Fayette county, to Isaac M'Donald, deceased; that before the said conveyance was executed, the said Darlington sold the residue of the said tract to the reverend David Smith, under an express stipulation that the said Smith should patent in his own name the whole of said tract and convey the part aforesaid to the said McDonald; that the said Smith always expressed a willingness so to do but was prevented by death; that the heirs of the said M.Donald have ever since enjoyed the peaceable and undisturbed possession of the said land, and have lately sold the same to Noble M'Cormick who declines paying them until a good conveyance is executed; that the executors of the said Smith are willing to execute the said conveyance but are unable to do so legally for want of written evidence Tof contract between their said testator and the said M'Donald.
