CHAPTER XC.

AN ACT

Granting relief to James English, a sergeant in the revolutionary army.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to James English, a sergeant in the Pennsylvania line in the revolutionary war, in captain Jacob Bower's company, or to his order, forty-eight dollars immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty-eight dollars to be paid half yearly, to commence on the first day of January eighteen hundred and eighteen.
