CHAPTER CI.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to regulate the payment of costs on indictments.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That in all criminal cases where a defendant or prosecutor is adjudged to pay the costs of prosecution, he shall, unless the grand or petit jury direct otherwise, pay with the other costs of prosecution, the sum of four dollars for the use of the county, to be taxed in the bill of costs.

Four dollars made payable to the county in criminal cases.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of any former law or laws as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same are hereby repealed.
