CHAPTER CXLIII.

AN ACT

Relative to the boroughs of Waynesburg and Greensburg.

Secr. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act entitled "An act to regulate fences, and to appoint appraisers in each township in the counties of Bedford, Northumberland, Westmoreland, Washington and Fayette, and to encourage the raising of swine," passed the twenty-seventh day of March, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-four, be, and the same is hereby repealed, so far as it respects and is in force within the borough of Waynesburg, in the county of Greene, and the borough of Greensburg, in 5 the county of Westmoreland.
