For the further advancement of money to certain Turnpike Road Companies.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and last subscrip- required to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, in favor of the president, managers and company of the Stoystown and Greensburg turnpike road company, for the sum of ten thousand dollars; in favor of the president, managers and company of the Bedford and Stoystown turnpike road company, for the sum of ten thousand dollars; in favor of the president, managers and company of the Chambersburg and Bedford turnpike road company, for the sum of ten thousand dollars; in favor of the president, managers and company of the Harrisburg, Carlisle and Chambersburg turnpike road company, for the sum of ten thousand dollars; and in favor of the president, managers and company of the Huntingdon, Cambria and Indiana turnpike road company, for the sum of ten thousand dollars: the several sums aforesaid to be paid in advance, on account of the last of the subscriptions on the part of the state heretofore made to the stock of the several companies aforesaid respectively. And as soon as any of the aforesaid payments shall be made, the president and treasurer of the company to which such payment shall be so made, shall deliver to the State Treasurer, for the use of the commonwealth, a certificate for the amount so paid to the stock of such company: Provided, That the sum hereby granted shall be expended in completing the said road, and not in discharging the debts of the companies heretofore incurred: And provided also, That the president, managers and company shall enter into bond with sufficient security that the money shall be so applied.
