CHAPTER VII.

AN ACT

For the relief of Charles Bowman, a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Charles Bowman, of Philadelphia county, or order, one hundred dollars immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars during life to be paid half yearly, commencing on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and nineteen.
