and with the same effect, as if he had been a citizen of this commonwealth, at the time of the purchase thereof by him: *Provided*, That nothing in this act contained, shall be con-Provisostrued to impair the vested rights of any other individual or individuals.

CHAPTER CXX.

AN ACT

Repealing the acts, entitled "An act, declaring Anderson's creek, in Clearfield county, and part of Le Beuff creek, in the county of Erie, public highways."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That from and after the passage of this act, the act Repeal of a passed the thirteenth day of March, one thousand eight hunformeract. dred and thirteen, declaring Anderson's creek, in Clearfield county, a public highway, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the act passed the thirtieth day of January, one Repeal of a thousand eight hundred and four, declaring Le Beuff creek, in former act, the county of Erie, from the town of Waterford, up to Brotherton's mill, a public highway, be, and the same is hereby

repealed.
