# CHAPTER V.

#### AN ACT

Vesting in Jane Shaw a certain escheated estate therein mentioned.

SECT. 1. BE in enucted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all the right, title, interest, claim and demand of this Commonwealth, of, in and to the personal estate of William Wallace, in the hands of administrators, or in the hands of any other person or persons, with the interest due or accrued thereon, be, and the same is hereby released to Jane Shaw, her heirs and assigns: Provided, That nothing in this act contained, shall in anywise prejudice the rights of individuals, or impair any other claim to the said personal estate than that which this Commonwealth has, or might have by reason of the said escheat.

### CHAPTER VI.

### AN ACT

SECT. 1. ### CHAPTER VII.

## A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to enable the Governor of this Commonwealth to incorporate a company for making an artificial road, by the best and nearest route from Waterford, in the county of Erie, through Meadville and Franklin, to the river Susquehanna, at or near the mouth of Anderson's creek, in Clearfield county; and also to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the town of Northumberland, in the county of Northumberland, by the best and nearest route to the West branch of the Susquehanna river, at or near the mouth of Anderson's creek, passing through Derrstown, Youngmanstown, Aaronsburg, Bellfonte and Milesburg."
