

CHAPTER XVI.

AN ACT

For the relief of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Masonic Hall situate in Chesnut street, in the city of Philadelphia, together with the lot of ground whereon the same is erected, be and the same is hereby exempted from taxation for the term of twenty years, from and after the passing of this act.*

CHAPTER XVII.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act to regulate the payment of costs on indictments."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That in all prosecutions where the petit jury trying the same, shall acquit the defendant or defendants, and shall determine by their verdict that the prosecutor shall pay the costs, the defendants bill for his subpoenas, serving the same, and attendance of his material and necessary witnesses, shall be included in the costs and paid accordingly: Provided, The said bill shall be sworn to, taxed by the clerk and allowed by the court trying the indictment.*
