CHAPTER XXII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act directing the mode of selecting and returning Jurors."

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the courts of common pleas and quarter sessions of Philadelphia county, shall be and they hereby are invested with the power and authority of directing the several days in each term of which the process for each and every pannel of jurors for the said courts shall be made returnable.

CHAPTER XXIII.

AN ACT

Prescribing the competency of witnesses under penal acts of Assembly.

SECT. 1. BE in enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That no person shall be excluded from being a witness, judge, juror or arbitrator, in any suit or prosecution under any penal act of Assembly, by reason of his being subject to the payment of any tax which would be diminished by the recovery of a fine or forfeiture under such prosecution.
