BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Michael Newman and Peter Winebrenner, trustees of the German reformed congregation of the borough of Hanover, in the county of York, or the survivor of them be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to sell a certain lot of ground in York street, in the borough aforesaid, known on the general plan of said borough by number eightythree, in behalf and for the benefit of the said congregation, and to execute a deed of conveyance, in fee simple, to any purchaser for the same, and such deed of conveyance shall be held available in law to all intents and purposes.
