CHAPTER XXVII.

AN ACT

Directing the recorder of deeds for the county of Westmoreland, to put a certain deed upon record.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the recorder of deeds for the county of Westmoreland, be, and he is hereby directed to admit and put upon record a certain deed of conveyance executed by William Elliott and Barbara his wife, for a tract of land in said county, to John Hindman, in fee simple, dated the twenty seventh day of July, one thousand seven hundred and ninety five, and acknowledged before John Johnston, a justice of the peace for the county of Allegheny, in the same manner as if the deed had been acknowledged in due form of law.
