

CHAPTER XLVI.

*AN ACT*

Declaring Stony Creek a public highway.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Stony Creek from its mouth up to Peter Berkey's mills, in the county of Somerset, shall be and the same is hereby declared a public highway for the passage of rafts, boats, and other water crafts.*

CHAPTER XLVII.

*AN ACT*

For the relief of the Georges creek trading company, in the county of Fayette.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the provisions of the act, entitled "An act to authorise the Connelsville navigation company, the Youghiogeny Bank of Pennsylvania, and the Farmers' and Mechanics' Bank of Fayette county, to recover the debts due to them, and for other purposes, passed the sixteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, be and the same are hereby extended to the Georges creek trading company, and the said company is hereby vested with all the privileges and subjected to all the restrictions contained in the said act, in the same manner and to the same extent, as if they were severally herein recited and re-enacted.*
