

CHAPTER LXV.

AN ACT

Authorising the appointment of an additional Auctioneer for the city of Pittsburg.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and is hereby authorised to appoint and licence one additional auctioneer for the city of Pittsburg, who shall give similar security, and in all other respects be placed precisely upon a similar footing with the auctioneer already authorised by law in the said city.

CHAPTER LXVI.

AN ACT

Confirming the title of Jacob Barncord, of Franklin county, to a certain house and lot therein mentioned.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all the right, title and interest which Peter Barncord, late of Franklin county, deceased, may have had to a certain house and lot of ground in the borough of Greencastle, in said county of Franklin, marked and known in the general plan of said borough by number one hundred and twenty two, be and the same is hereby vested in his son Jacob Barncord, his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and effectually as if said house and lot of ground had been conveyed to him by his said father in his lifetime: *Provided,* That nothing in this act shall be so

construed, as to affect or impair the private rights of any individual or individuals.

CHAPTER LXVII.

AN ACT

Authorising William Scott, of Mercer county, guardian of the minor children of Benjamin Lodge, deceased, to convey certain lands therein mentioned.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That William Scott of Mercer county, guardian of the persons and estates of the minor children of Benjamin Lodge, deceased, he and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to execute a good and sufficient deed or deeds of conveyance, for the following tracts of land, situate on the waters of Shenango, in the county of Mercer, surveyed and returned on warrants issued under the act of the third of April, seventeen hundred and ninety-two, in the following names, viz. One in the name of Aaron Levi, one in the name of John Kapp, one in the name of Daniel Williams, one in the name of John Leacock, one in the name of Nathan Falkner, and one in the name of Daniel Reas, all patented to a certain James Hamilton, since deceased, (who is represented to have held the same only as the agent or trustee of the aforesaid Benjamin Lodge, also deceased,) in pursurance of the actual settlement and residence of sundry persons, with whom contracts had been made by the said James Hamilton, for the sale and settlement of the same, to the said settlers or their assignees, agreeably to their several contracts, in the same manner and for the same intents and purposes, as the said James Hamilton in his life time would or could by law have been obliged to do and perform in the premises: *Provided,* That nothing herein contained shall affect or impair the right or title of
