## CHAPTER LXIX.

### *AN ACT*

To authorise Hugh Means to sell a tract of land belonging to the heirs of Thomas Woods, deceased.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Hugh Means, of Mercer county, be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered to sell, grant and convey all the right, title, interest, claim and estate of the heirs and legal representatives of Thomas Woods, late of Bedford county, deceased, of, in or to a certain tract of land, situate on the waters of Chartier's run, in Westmoreland county, granted by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to the said Thomas Woods, by patent, bearing date on the thirteenth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, and to receive and distribute the purchase money thereof, amongst the said heirs and legal representatives of Thomas Woods, deceased.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said Hugh Means shall before he proceeds to sell and convey the said tract of land, enter into a recognizance with one or more sufficient sureties, to be approved of by the orphan's court of Westmoreland county, conditioned for the faithful execution of the trust hereby reposed in him, and for the due distribution of the money arising from the sale of the said estate, to and amongst the heirs and legal representatives of the said Thomas Woods, deceased: *And provided always,* That nothing herein contained shall be so con-

strued as to affect or prejudice any legal title, right, interest or claim, other than those herein contained.

CHAPTER LXX.

AN ACT

Affixing certain lien on real estate in the district of Southwark and town-  
ship of Moyamensing.

Southwark.  
Real estate  
liable for

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-  
sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General  
Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the  
same,* That all real estate within the district of Southwark,  
in the county of Philadelphia, shall be subject to the payment  
of the debts hereafter contracted by the commissioners of the  
said district, for or by reason of any work done, or materials  
furnished for or in the curbing or paving any foot-way in  
front of said real estate, before any other lien hereafter cre-  
ated, and that the commissioners of said district be, and they  
are hereby authorised and empowered to collect the said debts,  
together with the uncollected taxes remaining due upon said  
real estate from the time of assessment, in the like manner  
as county rates and levies are collected.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority afore-  
said,* That all real estate within the township of Moyamensing,  
shall be subject to the payment of the debts hereafter con-  
tracted by the commissioners of the said township, for or by  
reason of any work done, or materials furnished for or in the  
pitching, curbing or paving any road, street, lane, court, alley  
or foot-way in the front of said real estate, before any other  
lien hereafter created, and that the commissioners of said  
township be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered  
to collect the said debts, together with the uncollected taxes  
remaining due upon said real estate, with interest there-  
on from the time of assessment, in the same manner as is di-  
rected in the first section of this act.
