

CHAPTER CX.

AN ACT

to extend the time for completing the Lewistown and Kishacoquillas turnpike road.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time for completing the Lewistown and Kishacoquillas turnpike road, is hereby extended to the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-two.*

CHAPTER CXI.

AN ACT

Making appropriations to defray certain expenses of Government therein mentioned.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That for the payment of the expenses hereinafter mentioned, the following sums are hereby appropriated, to wit:*

Clerk hire in the office of Secretary of the Commonwealth.

For clerk hire in the Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, for one year, two thousand three hundred dollars:

Audit. Genl.

For clerk hire in the Office of the Auditor General, nine hundred dollars, in addition to the permanent appropriation of one thousand dollars, and a further sum of sixty-five dollars, sixty cents, for extra clerk hire to George R. Horter for the last year:

For clerk hire in the Office of State Treasurer, eight hundred dollars in addition to the permanent appropriation already authorised by law:

For clerk hire in the Office of the Secretary of the Land

Land Office.

Office, for one year, commencing on the first day of April next, the sum of three thousand seven hundred dollars, in addition to the permanent appropriation already authorised:

Surveyor
General.

For clerk hire in the Office of the Surveyor General, for one year, commencing on the first of April next, the sum of two thousand two hundred dollars, in addition to the permanent appropriation already authorised:

And the clerk hire aforesaid shall be paid quarterly in the usual manner.

And the sums hereby appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer, out of any money in the Treasury, previous to which the officers holding the aforesaid offices shall exhibit their accounts and vouchers for said expenditure to the accountant department, to be adjusted and settled.
