

## CHAPTER CXXX.

## AN ACT

Authorising the Governor to procure on loan a sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to negociate a loan or loans in behalf of this commonwealth for a sum or sums of money not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, as he may find the same necessary, at an interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum, and the funds of this commonwealth are hereby pledged for the reimbursement of said loan with interest within any term not exceeding ten years, and in such instalments as may be agreed on by the contracting parties; and the Secretary of the Commonwealth is hereby directed to lay the proceedings of the Governor in the premises before the next legislature, within two weeks after the commencement of their next session. Loan of \$150,000.
