CHAPTER I.

AN ACT

Reducing the salaries of the Governor and Secretary of the Commonwealth.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from the third Tuesday of the present month, the salary of the Governor shall be four thousand dollars per annum, and the salary of the Secretary of the Commonwealth sixteen hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly at the treasury in the usual manner.
