CHAPTER VII.

*AN ACT*

To refund to James Herrington money paid by him to Daniel Perkins for painting the roof of the arsenal at Meadville.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay James Herrington or order, seventy-two dollars and eighty seven cents, in full for money paid by him to Daniel Perkins for painting the roof of the state arsenal at Meadville.*
