CHAPTER XVIII.

AN ACT

Vesting a title to thirty acres of land in Upper Mahonoy township, Northumberland county, in certain trustees and their successors, for the benefit of the congregations composed of Presbyterians and Lutherans.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the officers of the land office are hereby authori. Officers of sed and required to issue a warrant and complete a title on the kand of-receiving the usual office fees, for thirty acres of land, situate sed to comin Upper Mahonoy township, in Northumberland county, ad plete a title. joining lands of John Kares, Daniel Snyder, Jacob Reitz and George Boyer, deceased, unto trustees hereinafter mentioned and their successors, in trust and for the sole use and benefit of the Presbyterian and Lutheran congregations who now worship in the house thereon crected, and their successors.

Secr. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the trustees of the said congregations shall be three in number, and until others shall be elected shall consist of the following persons, viz. John Haas, Martin Zart-man and Jacob Trestler, who shall continue in office until tees. the first Tuesday in January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three, on which day, and on the same Tuesday of the same month every three years thereafter the members of the said congregations shall at a general meeting thereof elect by ballot three persons to serve as trustees to continue in office three years thereafter, and if any vacancy by death or Vacancies otherwise shall happen in the board of trustees, the congrega-how suptions may and they are hereby required to elect a person to sup-plied. ply such vacancy until the next triennial election in said congregations: Provided nevertheless, That if it should happen Proviso. that at any future time an election should not be held on the day above mentioned, it shall be lawful for the congregations aforesaid to elect at a future day to be agreed upon by the trustees, or a majority of them.
