

CHAPTER XXXVI.

AN ACT

In aid of the act for making the turnpike roads from Susquehanna to Waterford, and from Northumberland to Andersons creek, passed the twenty-second day of February, one thousand eight hundred and twelve.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor of this commonwealth is hereby authorised by license under his hand and the lesser seal of the commonwealth, to permit the president, managers and company of the Susquehanna and Waterford turnpike road, to erect such gate upon and across the said road, as may be necessary and sufficient to collect the tolls and duties granted to the said company by the act to which this is a supplement, for the second section of five miles of the said road south-eastwardly from the town of Waterford.

CHAPTER XXXVII.

AN ACT

For the relief of the heirs of James Moore, deceased, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorised and required to pay to the legal heirs or representatives of James Moore, deceased, the sum of nine hundred and forty-three
