

CHAPTER L.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act authorising the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the bank of the river Susquehanna opposite the borough of Harrisburg to Pittsburg."

Certain turnpike companies annually to elect six managers.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the stockholders of the Harrisburg, Carlisle and Chambersburg, the Chambersburg and Bedford, the Bedford and Stoystown Turnpike Road companies, shall from and after the passage of this act, elect six managers annually and no more, to transact the business of said companies.

Repeal.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as is altered or superceded by the foregoing section, is hereby repealed as far as respects the said companies.

CHAPTER LI.

AN ACT

Extending an act, entitled "An act securing to mechanics and others, payment for their labor and materials in erecting any house or other building within the city and county of Philadelphia," to the counties of Delaware, Bucks, Luzerne and Mifflin.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from the passage hereof, the act, entitled "An act securing to mechanics and others, payment for their labor and materials in erecting any house or other building

within the city and county of Philadelphia," passed March the seventeenth, one thousand eight hundred and six, with its supplement, passed the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eight, shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be in full force and operation in the counties of Delaware, Bucks, Luzerne and Mifflin; and mechanics and others in said counties shall have like remedy under said acts, as though they were herein enacted at full length.

CHAPTER LII.

AN ACT

Explanatory of the act for the better regulation of the city of Philadelphia and districts adjoining, and preserving the navigation of the river Schuylkill.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled "An act for the better regulation of the city of Philadelphia and districts adjoining, and preserving the navigation of the river Schuylkill," shall not be so construed as to authorise the courts of quarter sessions of the county of Philadelphia, to make any order upon any petition for opening a street, lane or alley over the public squares, and State House yard, or either of them.* Court not to make an order for opening any street, &c.
