CHAPTER LXIII.

AN ACT

To authorise the Roman Catholic Society worshipping at the church of St. Mary's, in Philadelphia, to amend their charter of incorporation.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That "The members of the religious society of Roman Catholics, inhabiting the city and county of Philadelphia, and belonging to the congregation worshipping at the church of Saint Mary's, in the city of Philadelphia, incorporated by an act of assembly of the state of Pennsylvania," passed the thirteenth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-eight, by the name, style and title of "the Trustees of the Roman Catholic Society worshipping at the church of Saint Mary's," be, and they are

hereby empowered to improve, amend and alter the charter of incorporation granted them by the aforesaid act, in the same manner and with the same privileges and powers, as corporations established by virtue of an act of assembly, passed the sixth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An act to confer on certain associations of the citizens of this commonwealth, the powers and immunities of corporations or bodies politic in law."
