High constable to

elected and qualified agreeably to the act to which this is a supplement, is hereby authorised and empowered to issue his collect taxes, precept as often as occasion may require, directed to the high constable, or to such person as may be appointed from time to time by the town council, to collect all taxes assessed or laid in each and every year, and the person who shall be appointed collector each year, shall give his bond with sufficient security for the true and faithful performance of the duties enjoined on him.

Repeal.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of any former law as is hereby altered or supplied, shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER LXXXII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act authorising the Governor to appoint commissioners to view the ground from the west end of the Harrisburg bridge to the river Juniatta at or near Millerstown."

CHAPTER LXXXIII.

AN ACT

Annexing to Lebanon county that part of East Hanover and Bethel townships which lies north of the Blue or Kittatiny mountain, in Dauphin county.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passage of this act, so much of the townships of East Hanover and Bethel, in the county of Dauphin as lies north of the Blue or Kittatiny mountain, shall be and compose a part of the county of Lebanon, and that part of East Hanover township which is hereby annexed to Lebanon county, shall be attached to East Hanover township, in the said county of Lebanon, and that part of Bethel township which is hereby annexed to Lebanon county, shall be attached to Bethel township, in the said county of Lebanon.
