CHAPTER LXXXIX.

AN ACT

For the relief of captain Robert Orr, of the county of Armstrong.

Secr. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to captain Robert Orr, of Armstrong county, or order, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars immediately after the passing of this act, in consideration of his services and losses during the revolutionary war: Provided, That the above sum shall be considered as a full compensation for said services and losses, including all claims that he may have upon the state for military services.

CHAPTER XC.

A SUPPLEMENT

Yo the act, entitled "An act for the promotion of agriculture and dymestic manufactures."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is herrby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Philadelphia society for the promotion of agriculture, shall receive annually from the county commissioners of Philadelphia county, out of the county tax assessed on the city and county of Philadelphia, the sum of fifty dollars for every member which the freemen of the said city and county are, or shall be respectively entitled to elect to the House of Representatives of this commonwealth, for the purposes designated in the act, entitled "An act for the promotion of agriculture and domestic manufactures;" and the
