CHAPTER CIX:

AN ACT

Respecting the erection of certain gates on the York and Gettysburg and the Milford and Owego turnpike roads.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That no toll gate shall be erected or set up on the York and Gettysburg turnpike road, within half a mile of the borough of York; and the gate now erected in the town called Buttstown, shall be removed by the president, managers and company of said road, within six months after the passing of this act, to a distance not less than one half mile from the borough of York. No toll gate to be erected within half a mile of York borough.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the first day of June next, no toll gate shall be erected, kept or maintained across the Milford and Owego turnpike road, within two miles of the town of Milford, in Pike county. Nor within two miles of Milford.
