CHAPTER CXIII.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled, "An act granting a sum of money to aid in removing obstructions out of Sheermans creek,"

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time for completing the work, and of final settling the accounts of the commissioners authorised by the act to which this is a supplement, be extended for one year, from and after the passing of this act.

CHAPTER CXIV.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act establishing an academy in Chester county, passed the thirtieth March, eighteen hundred and eleven.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That as often hereafter as a vacancy occurs by the expiration of the term, death, resignation or otherwise of any trustee or trustees of the Chester county academy, it shall and may be lawful for the remaining trustees for the time being, to supply any such vacancy by a new appointment under such rules and regulations as the board of trustees may prescribe for that purpose; and every trustee or trustees appointed, shall have the like powers and serve for the same term as is prescribed and directed by the act to which this is a supplement; and so much of the said act as directs the
