

CHAPTER CXXVIII.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled, "An act to incorporate the Kensington District of the Northern Liberties."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners appointed by virtue of the act to which this is a further supplement, be and they are hereby authorised to permit markets to be holden at the market-house, situate on Beach and Maiden streets, in the Kensington district of the Northern Liberties, at any time before eight o'clock in the morning of the first day of the week, during the months of June, July, August and September, in every year.

CHAPTER CXXIX.

AN ACT

To extend the time for patenting of lands in the seventeen townships of Luzerne, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the several provisions contained in the third and fourth sections of the act, entitled, "A further supplement to the act, entitled, an act for offering compensation to the Pennsylvania claimants of certain lands in the seventeen townships of Luzerne, and for other purposes therein mentioned," passed on the twenty-third of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eleven, and every matter and thing therein mentioned, shall be, and the same are hereby revived in as full and ample a manner as if the same were Certain provisions of a former act revived.
