missioner, or auditor, within the county of Bucks, shall be eligible to the office of county treasurer, until three years shall have elapsed after the expiration of his official duties as commissioner or auditor.

CHAPTER CXXXI.

AN ACT

For the relief of Joel Bailey, late deputy Sergeant-at-arms.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer is hereby empowered to pay to Joel Bailey, late deputy sergeant-at-arms, the sum of one hundred and thirty-three dollars and seventy-five cents, being the amount of a warrant drawn by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, on the treasurer of Fayette county, which said sum the state treasurer shall demand and receive from the treasurer of Fayette county.
