AN ACT

For the relief of Peter Gerhart, Henry Snyder, and John Wilfong, soldiers, and Catharine Nungesser, Catharine Curry and Barbara Stahle, the widows of revolutionary soldiers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Peter Gerhart, of Columbia county, Henry Snyder, of Adams county, and John Wilfong, of Montgomery county, soldiers of the revolution, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 2. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Catharine Nungesser, of Columbia county, Catharine Curry, of Allegheny county, and Barbara Stahle, of Lancaster county, the widows of revolutionary soldiers, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
