A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled, "An act to incorporate the city of Lancaster."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the select and common councils of the city of Lancaster may, whenever they deem it necessary, confer upon the aldermen of said city, the jurisdiction, power and authority, to recover summarily, or by penal action, as the case may be, any fines and forfeitures inflicted for the violation of the provisions of any ordinances hereafter enacted and ordained by said councils, for the government of said city: *Provided*, said fines and forfeitures do not exceed one hundred dollars: *And provided further*, That in all summary convictions under ordinances, where fines, forfeitures or imprisonment are inflicted, the person or persons convicted may appeal to the next term of the Mayor's Court of said city, within ten days after conviction, on entering security approved by the alderman or justice.

Councils may give the aldermen jurisdiction to recover fines & forfeitures.

SECTION 2. The act of the twelfth of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, and of the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, the first entitled "An act for the better regulation of the city of Lancaster, and relative to the repair of public bridges in Lancaster county," and the second entitled "An act for the better regulation of the city of Lancaster, and relative to the repair of the public bridges in Lancaster county," passed the twelfth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight, be and the same are hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to laying out roads, and assessing the damages occasioned by laying out the same, in the city of Lancaster: *Provided*, That all damages which have been sustained by the laying out of any streets, lanes, alleys or roads, under the provision of the above mentioned acts, and remain unpaid, shall be paid agreeably to the provisions of said acts.
