A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the "Act to alter the judiciary system of this Commonwealth.

For the relief of James McAnulty.

AN ACT

Granting compensation to Martha Levi Adams, for a tract of donation land.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Martha Levi Adams, of the city of Philadelphia, daughter of lieutenant James Morris Jones, deceased, or to her order, four hundred dollars, in full compensation for a tract of donation land, to which her late father was entitled for revolutionary services.
