AN ACT

Providing for the collection of part of the road tax of Franklin township Allegheny county, in money.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall and may be lawful for the supervisors of Franklin township in the county of Allegheny, to assess and levy a road tax on all property and trades made taxable by the existing laws, not exceeding five mills on the dollar of the adjusted valuation thereof, and to demand and receive in money half a mill on the dollar of the tax so assessed, any thing in any former act or acts to the contrary notwithstanding.
