AN ACT

To refund one hundred thousand dollars, appropriated to repairs of Canal and Rail Roads, and to apply three hundred thousand dollars to the payment of Loans.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the internal improvement fund be authorized and directed, to refund to the Treasury, out of any money they may hereafter receive, applicable to purposes of internal improvement, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, appropriated by a law of the twenty-third day of December last, for the repair of the Pennsylvania canal and rail road, to be repaid out of any moneys which may be hereafter received, applicable to the repairs of the public works. \$100,000 to be repaid to the treasury, from any money that may come into the internal imp't fund.

SECTION 2. *The commissioners of the internal improvement fund, are authorized and directed to apply three hundred thousand dollars of the loan effected on Tuesday, the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, to the payment of the loans made under the provisions of the act of the twenty-seventh of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, if such payment be accepted, and if not accepted, in whole or in part, then such part thereof as may not be accepted by the loan holders under said act, to be paid to the loanholders of the loan effected under the act of the thirtieth of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-four.* \$300,000 to be applied to the payment of the loan of the 27th Jan. 1834, &c.
