AN ACT

Increasing the salary of the Auditor General and the State Treasurer,
and to provide for additional clerk hire in said offices.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, From the great increase of business, in the accountant departments of this Commonwealth, and the consequent increase of labor and responsibility, and also in consideration that the salaries of the officers are not equivalent to the duties required of them, and as it is not the policy of Pennsylvania to require the services of her public agents without an adequate compensation: Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the salary of the Auditor General of the Commonwealth shall hereafter be one thousand six hundred dollars, annually, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

S. Treasurer's

SECTION 2. The sum for clerk hire, in said office, shall be four thousand dollars, annually, to enable the Auditor General to employ an additional clerk or clerks, as the business of the office may require.

SECTION 3. The salary of the State Treasurer shall be one thousand six hundred dollars, annually, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 4. The sum for clerk hire, in the State Treasury, shall be three thousand four hundred dollars, annually, to enable the Treasurer to employ an additional clerk or clerks, as the business of the office may require.
