AN ACT

To authorize the Governor to employ agents to negotiate the loans of this Commonwealth.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor of the Commonwealth is hereby empowered, if he shall deem it expedient, to employ an agent or agents, residents here or abroad, to negotiate, either in the United States or, if necessary, in Europe, such loans for the Commonwealth as now are or may hereafter be authorized by law: *Provided,* That no person a member of either House of the Legislature, when the loan is authorized, be capable of receiving said agency.

AN ACT

To confirm certain deeds made by the executors of Adam Fleck, late of Montgomery county, deceased.

WHEREAS, Adam Fleck, late of Gwinnedd township, Montgomery county, deceased, by his last will and testament, dated the twenty-ninth April, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, devised to his two sons, Daniel Fleck and Jacob Fleck, two certain tracts of land, situate in said county, which said tracts of land were severally valued and appraised agreeably to the provisions of the said will, and the said devisees, (who were also the executors of said deceased) having refused to take said tracts at the valuation thereof, the legatees and heirs, or their legal representatives, of said deceased, agreed that the said executors should sell said tracts of land at public sale.
