

forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.

SECTION 3. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Gravel of Montgomery county, John Myers of Perry county, Jacob Hefflebower of Lancaster county, and David Likens of Delaware county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their orders, a gratuity of forty dollars to each for their revolutionary services.

AN ACT

Changing the name of the township of Conneauttee, in the county of Erie, to that of Washington, and the town of Conemaugh, in the county of Cambria, to that of Johnstown.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the name of the township of Conneauttee, in the county of Erie, be altered to that of Washington, and that hereafter, for all purposes, Washington be the name of said township.

SECTION 2. The name of the town of Conemaugh, in the county of Cambria, is hereby altered to that of Johnstown, and that hereafter, for all purposes, Johnstown be the name of said town.
