AN ACT

Vesting the right of this Commonwealth to the escheated estate of Diana James, deceased, in Sarah Dexter and Jane Nelson wife of Ralph Nelson.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the title which this Commonwealth may have acquired by reason of an escheat for want of heirs, or known kindred of Diana James, deceased, of the city of Philadelphia, in and to the personal property whereof the said Diana James died possessed, is hereby vested in Sarah Dexter and Jane Nelson, wife of Ralph Nelson.

AN ACT

Concerning the boroughs of Hanover, Lewisberry and Marcus Hook.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the borough constable of the borough of Hanover, in the county of York, is hereby authorized and required to execute all process, civil and criminal, which may be directed to him, with like effect as township constables may execute the same, under and subject to all the provisions which now by law are applicable to the duty of township constables in the execution of process, and subject to the same liabilities and penalties as such township constables are now by law subject to, and the said borough constable shall receive for the execution of such process such fees as township constables now by law are entitled to receive, and the said borough constable before he shall be authorized to execute civil process, shall give the same se-

Duties of borough constables.

Security to be given. curity, to be approved in the same manner as township constables now give.

How chosen.

SECTION 2. The qualified electors of the borough of Lewisberry, in the county of York, shall at the same time and place they elect their borough officers, elect two respectable citizens of said borough, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next court of Quarter Sessions, of the said county, one of whom shall be appointed by the court to serve as constable in the same manner with like power and authority, and subject to the same regulations, penalties, and give like security as are provided and contained in the laws now existing, or that may hereafter be enacted, concerning constables within this Commonwealth, and shall serve and execute all manner of process which may by law be directed to and served by township constables with like effect, and shall receive for the execution of process such fees as township constables now by law are entitled to receive, and the constable so appointed shall do and perform all the duties required to be done by the high constable of said borough, in pursuance of the act of incorporation and of the by-laws and ordinances, and the election for officers of said borough is hereby changed after the next election is over, to the third Friday in March, in each and every year thereafter.

Marcus Hook elect 4 citizens for town council.

SECTION 3. Hereafter the qualified voters of the borough of Marcus Hook, in Delaware county, shall elect four citizens, who shall be the town council of said borough; the high constable of said borough shall hereafter possess like powers and authority, and be subject to the same regulations and penalties as are provided by the existing laws of the Commonwealth, relating to township constables, and so much of the act to incorporate sundry boroughs and for other purposes, passed the eighth of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty, as is hereby altered, be and the same is hereby repealed.
