AN ACT

Extending the bounds of the borough of Erie.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the bounds of the borough of Erie, in the county of Erie, be and they are hereby extended northwardly from the present northern boundary thereof, thirteen hundred feet into the bay of Presque Isle; the eastern and western boundaries of said extension, to be in a direct line with the present eastern and western bounds of the same borough.

SECTION 2. Until the legislature shall otherwise provide, the burgess and town council of the said borough, shall have power to enact ordinances for the preservation of the canal basin, now being erected in the bay of Presque Isle, the pier work thereof, and all public bridges, wharves, and other appendages and constructions, connected therewith, and for regulating the manner in which the same may be used by the public, with such restrictions, prohibitions and penalties, as shall appear conducive to the public interest and welfare of the Commonwealth.
