AN ACT.

To revive and continue an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Asbury Beneficial Society of the city and county of Philadelphia," passed the seventh day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

Charter extended

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Asbury beneficial society of the city and county of Philadelphia," passed the seventh day of May, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, be, and the same is hereby revived and continued for the term of fifteen years, from the seventh of May, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two; and all the property, estate, claims and demands, which of right belonged to the said corporation at the time its charter expired, are hereby vested in and restored to the said corporation, with full power and authority to have, hold, take, enjoy, collect and receive the same, as if the act originally incorporating said society had not expired.

SECTION 2. The legislature hereby reserve the power to revoke and annul this charter, whenever, in their opinion, it may be injurious to the citizens of this commonwealth.
