A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the village of Clarion, in the county of Clarion, into a borough, and for other purposes."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the election of borough officers, Election of as provided for in the second section of the act of incorporation, passed the sixth day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-one, shall hereafter be held on the third Friday in March, instead of the second Monday in May; and on the third Friday of March, eighteen hundred and forty-three, the qualified voters of said borough shall elect one respectable citizen, residing therein, who shall be styled the chief burgess, and one citizen as assistant burgess, who in the absence of the chief burgess, shall possess all and singular the powers and authorities of the said chief burgess: *And further,* The citizens of said borough shall elect six respectable citizens, on the day aforesaid, to be a town council, in manner following, Council viz: two persons to hold their offices for the term of one year, two persons for the term of two years, and two persons for the term of three years, and at each and every annual election thereafter, to elect two persons to hold their offices for the term of three years, respectively; and all and singular the duties of the president of the town council are hereby transferred to the chief burgess, who is hereby authorized, in case of a tie, to give the casting vote.
