AN ACT

To incorporate the Cumberland Valley Mutual Protection company of Dickinson township, Cumberland county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Thomas Craig Miller, Charles P. Cummins, John Moore, of Dickinson township, David W. McCulloch, James Weakley, George Martin, William Moore, Samuel Galbraeth, James Greason, Thomas Paxton, William Barr, Joseph Culver and Andrew G. Miller, and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them, in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be, and are hereby constituted and declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the style and title of the "Cumberland Valley Mutual Protection company," and shall have all the rights and privileges of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three. The first thirteen named persons in this act, shall constitute the first board of managers, to carry this act into effect. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer.

SECTION 2. No policy shall be insured by said corporation, until application be made for insurance for fifty thousand dollars at least.
